

TSAY CORPORATION SCHOLARSHIP Instructions for 2006/2007 Academic Year

Scholarships are one time grants of \$3,000 to full-time students (\$1,500 for Fall and \$1, 500 for Spring. One scholarship awarded per category.) **DEADLINE IS JUNE 30th by 5:00 PM**

The Tsay Corporation Scholarship supports students who receive little or no financial aid resources towards a college education. All applicants must be in good standing with the Tribe and school and meet the following criteria for eligibility:

“Lets Get Started Scholarship” a merit based scholarship for incoming freshmen Applicants must be enrolled Ohkay Owingeh tribal members who have recently graduated from high school and are entering as a first year college freshmen with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5, and be accepted into either a 2 or + year accredited college or university as a full-time student.

- Official High School Transcript(s)
- Certificate of Indian Blood – Ohkay Owingeh
- Letter of Acceptance to Accredited College
- Official Class Schedule as proof of full-time status
- Essay (double-spaced, typed, minimum 500 words)

“Many Paths to Success Scholarship” a merit based scholarship for Vocational/Trade Student Applicants must be enrolled Ohkay Owingeh tribal members enrolled in a two year, accredited vocational/trade school as a full-time student, with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5.

- Official High School Transcript(s)
- Certificate of Indian Blood – Ohkay Owingeh
- Letter of Acceptance to Accredited Vocation/Trade School/Institution
- Official Class Schedule as proof of full-time status
- Essay (double-spaced, typed, minimum 500 words)
“Why I chose my field of study.”

“Your Almost There Scholarship” a merit based for Junior/Senior + year Undergraduate Applicants must be enrolled Ohkay Owingeh tribal members who have been identified through an accredited + year college/university as either a Junior or Senior level student with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or better.

- Official High School Transcript(s)
- Certificate of Indian Blood – Ohkay Owingeh
- Proof of Junior or Senior Level status from College/University
- Official Class Schedule as proof of full-time status
- Essay (double-spaced, typed, minimum 500 words)
